- Decontamination kits & supplies are not in an area being treated with pesticides.
- Decontamination water must not be used for mixing pesticides.
- Decontamination & emergency eyeflush water must, at all times when it is available to workers or handlers, be of a quality and temperature that will not cause illness or injury when it contacts the skin or eyes or if it is swallowed. –EPA: *How to Comply Manual September 2005*

Portable Decontamination Kits Should Contain:

Verify Presence & Integrity

1.	Contents container (* nylon carrying bag)	
2.	Container labeled	
3.	Inventory of the items in the kit, taped to the lid or in a plastic bag in the kit	
4.	WPS information on decontamination	
5.	Water for washing (* Three 1-gal portable water containers- <i>use fresh water, date, refresh regularly & with use</i>).	
6.	Water for emergency eyeflush (*Two 16-oz. bottles of emergency eyewash solution)	
7.	Soap (* One 4-oz. bottle of antibacterial hand & body soap)	
8.	Single-Use Towels (*4 extra-large disposable towels)	
9.	Clean Change of Clothes (*One limited-use coverall)	
10.	Temporary storage container (Bags for putting contaminated items (Not required))	
11.	Decontamination kit station signs (Not required)	

Portable Eyewash Solution Checks & Replacement

Check & Replace if...

Date/Initials

1.	Product has expired or will within one month	
2.	Bottle is damaged, seal is broken or contents have been used	
3.	There is floating debris or any contamination in the bottle
