Spill Kits Should Contain:

Verify Presence & Integrity

Date/Initials

1.	Contents container (polyethylene chemical resistant with screw top lid; can also be used as spill container)	
2.	Container labeled with type of spill it is to be used for & taped shut (broken tape will indicate kit check needed)	
3.	A list of the items in the kit, taped to the lid or in a plastic bag in the kit	
4.	Instructions on waste disposal, taped to the lid or in a plastic bag in the kit	
5.	Gloves (heavy duty Nitrile glove- at least 15 mil)	
6.	Goggles	
7.	Tyvek® coverall (plastic or other barrier coated coveralls)	
8.	Temporary storage container (Bags for lining 20-gal storage container, separate pail may be used, not listed)	
9.	Chalk or grease pencil (for marking spill area on floor)	
10.	Sorbent pads, socks	
11.	Loose absorbent (corn cob, kitty litter, vermiculite, saw dust)	
12.	Sweeping compound	
13.	Permanent marker (for marking spill container after clean-up)	
14.	Cornell hazardous waste tags (EH&S)	
15.	Dust pan or small shovel (plastic preferable)	
16.	Small broom	
17.	Wash or dispensing bottle (for wetting down small spills)	
18.	Single-use paper towels	
16.	Warning sign	
19.	Spill kit station signs (Not required)
